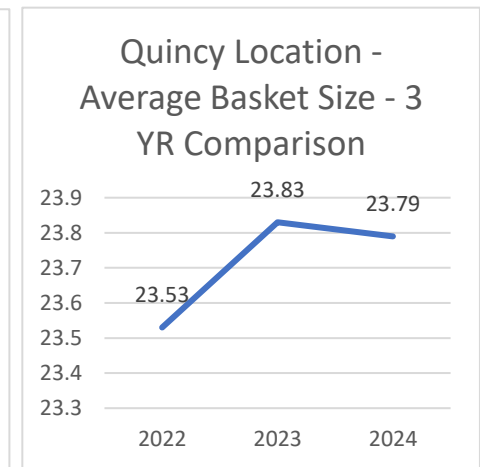
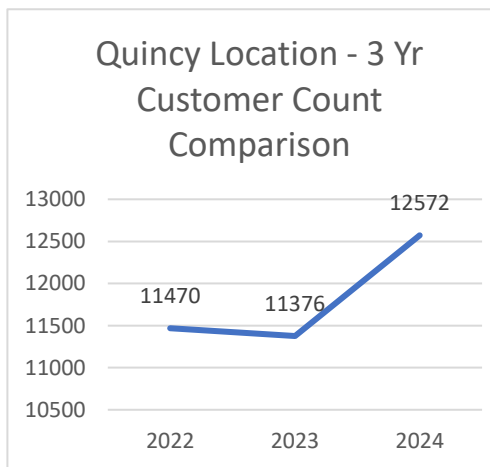
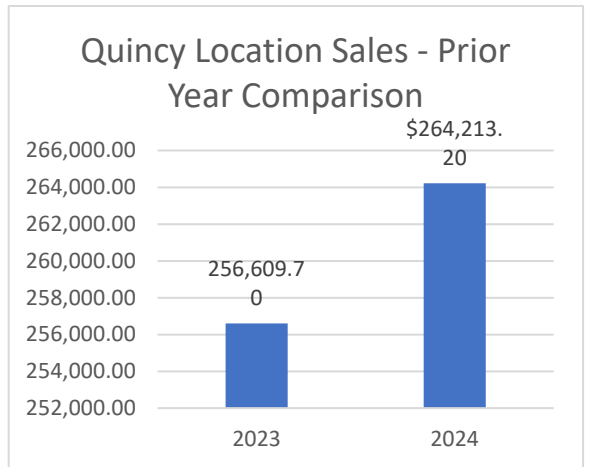
Prior Year Comparison – Increase of 4.3%

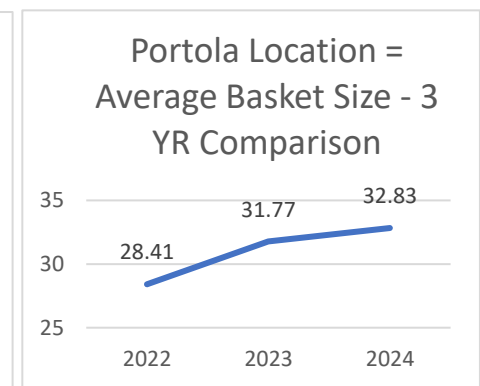
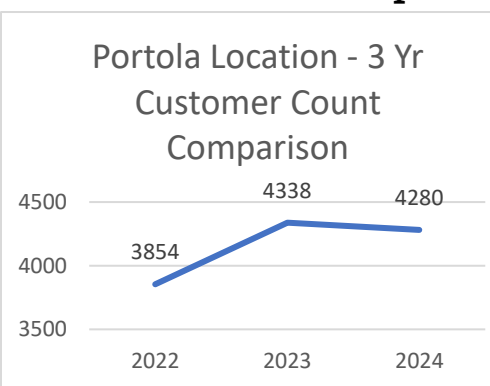
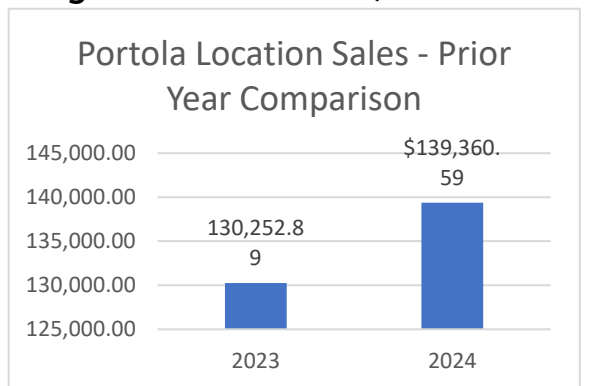
Prior Year Comparison - Increase of 3.0%
